The San Francisco Region's racing sea-

son is in full swing. We are soon to have the second race of the season. Since RDC membership is based on the calendar year, your membership expired on 12/31/04. We'd like for you to continue your membership into 2005 by sending in your \$30 with the form located elsewhere in the newsletter. Remember that the due date is May 15. If your envelope is dated after May 15, you need to include the late fee – total due is \$40.

Why should you join? Because the RDC is far more than just 45 years of putting on the only SCCA Enduro in the SF Region. We act as a clearinghouse for driver concerns, complaints and suggestions. Some issues are acted upon directly by the RDC; others are addressed with individuals, chiefs or the SFR Board of Directors. There is an RDC Driver Representative assigned to either fendered or formula cars who is there with you at grid and impound. The Driver Rep can help you with protests and other problems. The RDC has developed a Driver Mentor Program to help any of our members become better drivers.

The RDC administers a separate season points championship with awards presented at a season-end banquet. Also awarded at the banquet are a collection of giant perpetual trophies to outstanding drivers, cherished workers and the fast and/or lucky Enduro winners. We publish "Drivers Meeting", a monthly newsletter of articles and information of interest to drivers.

If you joined the RDC at the end of the year so you could run the Enduro, join now for this year and enjoy all of the benefits of RDC membership throughout the entire year. And, if you join at the beginning of the year, membership costs only \$30 (it will soon be \$40) rather than \$50 at the end of the year. Why is that? Because we want you as a participating member all year long!

Minutes of Meeting, RDC Board, Mar. 5, 2005, at Thunderhill Raceway

- 1. Minutes of previous meeting approved as revised.
- 2. L. Leijdecker-Ott presented copies of Treasurer's report for 2004 & through January 2005.

The three signatures on the bank account signature card must be: Secretary, Treasurer & one other officer per bank

Investigation is needed as to whether we need a tax I.D. number as a corporation. We need to determine our corporate status. G. Ott & L. Leijdecker-Ott will go through stored boxes to try to determine this.

Treasurer's report will be available for member review and a note will be placed in the newsletter to that effect.

2. D. Allen reports that he may be able to obtain the display cases through a dealer in Willows. This would save delivery problems. The cases will most likely go in the third floor observation area. They must be of the locking type. 3. D. Allen reports that Thunderhill

feels there is a greater need for a metal

grandstand than a new scale pad. Dave Vodden suggests that we donate the grandstand and put the RDC logo or similar on it. Greg Mercurio will follow up through SCCA regarding the need for the scale pad.

- 4. Jim Molinari has indicated that he will not be continuing participation on the Board. Office of Secretary thus becomes open.
- 5. A motion was passed that the RDC Board will send a letter to the SCCA Board regarding the scheduling of open wheel cars prior to the Enduro. We will indicate that we want them to have a two-day-only schedule rather than making them be there for three days to participate on only two. G. Ott will draft letter for Board review.
- 6. The survey to be developed by L. Devlin regarding member preference for the type and location of the Annual Banquet needs to be developed rather quickly to allow time for Board review and possible revisions.
- 7. Certificates will be issued to Drivers' School instructors for their dues reduction. This will allow for better tracking of expenses.
- 8. Open positions are: Secretary, Treasurer, No-Contact Program Chair, Driver Training Coordinator and Enduro Chair.
- 9. The Justin Hall team has not returned the trophies they were presented before the results were official from last year's Enduro. G. Ott will draft a letter asking for their return.

- 10. Membership cards are probably not a good idea at this time.
- 11. D. Allen has not found decals yet.
- 12. The possibility of having Vintage cars at the Illgen Enduro or of having a separate Enduro for Vintage cars was discussed. A big problem is that they don't meet current GCR specifications. B. John will follow up.
- 13. D. Allen, acting on behalf of SCCA Board asked what would make the WSC (PCRRC) be a better draw. Several ideas were advanced including making it invitational only based on track lap times not class finishing position.
- 14. Current membership was reported as 49 with 169 not having renewed yet from 2004.
- 15. \*T. Linerud was unable to stay for meeting. He reported through G. Ott that:

He has access to the web site from A. Banta and will begin updating it. He has not yet contacted SCCA to create a link on an Issues type forum until he has created one for RDC first.

22. Next meeting will be Saturday night April 2 at or near Laguna Seca. Time and exact location TBD.
